

### Year 6 Production and Graduation










#### **SUMMER HOLIDAYS**

### Aahil Hussain (5A) and Ayaana Rehan (2K).


Both children won a bike for their excellent attendance over the academic year. We hope you both have fun riding your bikes (wearing your safety helmets of course!) over the summer.
